The County's traditional and agriculture RLF, which are administered by KJM Consulting, was pitched to several companies over the course of the year.

 Empire Farmstead Brewing Company repaid the RLF loan and the majority of the Agriculture Loan Fund, which was fortunate given their filing for bankruptcy late in 2019.
